AMBULANCE



Thanks for **HSE Ireland and Lifeline Ambulance Services**, two ambulances were delivered to the **Kharkiv and Donetsk regions**, fully equipped with all the necessary equipment.

These vehicles will help to directly treat and evacuate the wounded from conflict areas to healthcare facilities accordingly.

Additionally, **thanks to Care UK Charity**, we were also able to **deliver one additional vehicle to Kharkiv** specifically for the transportation of people with disabilities to facilitate further civilian evacuations.

This month, we provided direct assistance to **10 Ukrainian families** with disabled children from various different regions of Ukraine.





